



## Mrs. Phillips' Weekly Focus February 11th - 15th, 2019

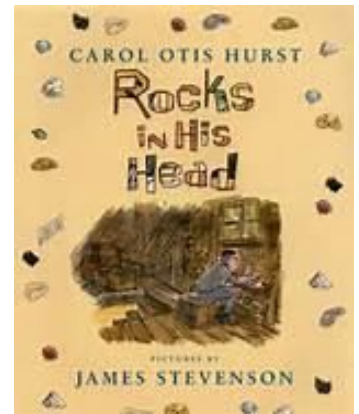
Our Valentine Party will be Thursday at 1:45. Please let me know if you want to donate something or come in to help out. A list with class names was sent home last week.

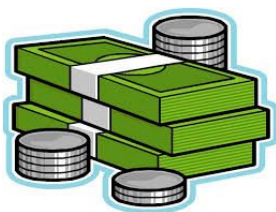
