Contractions

A contraction is a word made by putting <u>two</u> words together. When words are joined in a contraction, an **apostrophe** (') is used to show where a letter or letters have been left out.

> Pronoun Contractions: I will = I'll they will = they'll she is = she's | It is = It's they have = they've you are = you're

Verb Contractions: has not = hasn't had not = hadn't was not = wasn't did not = didn't could not = couldn't should not = shouldn't should have = should've could have = could've would have = would've

Example: We've gone swimming every day, but we won't go tamorrow
