

## Mrs. Phillips' Weekly Focus September 17-21, 2018

This Friday is our field trip to McCloud Nature Park. Be sure to have your student wear weather appropriate clothing - we will be outside all day, shoes appropriate for walking - no flip flops, and to bring a lunch if they are not buying one from school. We will go no matter what the weather - and will be outside all day!

Reading: (LA Standards 3.RF.5, 3.RN.1, 3.RN.23.RN.3, 3.RV.1.3,RV.2,3.W.1, 3.W.3)
This will be our end of Unit review week. Homework will be assigned Monday and Tuesday, and will need to be signed by a parent, grandparent, or responsible adult.

U1W6: This will be a review week. We will review all concepts cover so far and have a test on Thursday. There will be a multiple choice section and a written response section - both will be taken on the computer.

There will also be a vocabulary test on Thursday that will cover all tested vocabulary words in stories 1-5. Those words can be found in previous weekly focus pages.

## Spelling (LA Standard 3.W.6.2)

This will be a review week in spelling as well. There will be a 50 word (with 10 bonus words) test on Thursday. All words are words from the previous five lists. The spelling list was sent home Friday, Sept. 14th. There will not be a trial test on Wednesday this week, only the final test on Thursday. ## English (LA Standard 3.W.6.1)

This will also be a review week in grammar. There will be a Grammar test on Thursday. A study guide will come home on Monday and be due (signed) Wednesday for 5 bonus points. It will cover all the grammar rules so far. To find them, please see previous weekly focus pages.

This week students will continue with multiplication. Friday's 10 minute test will be over the fours.

We will continue with our studies of the nature of science. We will work through lessons 3 and 4 . We will learn about questions scientists ask, how they answer them, skills they use, and the Scientific method. There will be a 6-10 question quiz at the end of each lesson.
